- The Spanish high-speed line AVE has been developed by RENFE and covers the following routes in the south of Spain:
 - Madrid-Sevilla
 - Lanzaderas C. Real and Puertollano
 - Talgo 200 Malaga
 - Talgo 200 Cadiz Huelva
 - Talgo 200 Algeciras

for a total amount of 481 km*




• Despite the fact that since '95 the network was not lengthened, the traffic grew by 7,5% per year *



% traffic increase '95-'99 on REFE network



AVE - Alta Velocidad

- The 2000-2007 Development Plan of the Spanish Transport Ministry allocates funds to extend and refurbish the entire Spanish railways network *
- In particular, between 2003-2010 the high-speed network will be completed with the following new stretches:
 - Madrid-Lerida
 - Madrid-Barcelona
 - Madrid-Valencia-Alicante
 - Madrid-Malaga
 - Barcelona-France **





 Thanks to network development, Spanish Transport Ministry estimates foresee that within 2010 AVE traffic will reach around 37 million of passengers per year:

Madrid-Lerida: 4,5 ml.


Madrid-Siviglia: 3,9 ml.



The Company - General overview

 In Madrid Atocha railway station Receco manages 3 point of sales (around 1.100 sm.), and additional 670 sm. are immediately available for the opening of 2 further point of sales


- In Sevilla railway station the Company is present with 2 outlets of 740 sm., with the possibility to use additional 600 sm.
- The 2 locations present in Cordoba railway station cover around 400 sm.
- Receco also manages 2 point of sales in Castellon and Murcia shopping malls



The Company - Locations



- Atocha railway station is located in the heart of Madrid, close to important monuments (Prado and Reine Sofia museums, the Botanical Gardens): for this reason the station benefits from tourist flows too
- Built in 1892, it is a Spanish historical monument and thanks to the restructuring program "Plan General" it has been completely refurbished in the first '90: nowadays it represents one of the most important traffic hub of the city


The Company - Locations

- Also Sevilla railway station is located in the centre of the city, close to important shopping street and to "La Giralda" tower, Sevilla's symbol
- Built between 1987-1991, it is considered one of the best example of modern railway station architecture and as a matter of fact in 1993 the architect was awarded for the project


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








Acquisition rationale
